

FACT SHEET: EYETOP + DVD video entertainment system

What is the Eyetop + DVD system? The system is the world's first portable, personal and private video entertainment system.

What other product is similar to it? We have all seen people wearing and using portable CD players to enjoy their favorite tunes anywhere. The Eyetop system changes the CD player to a DVD player and adds a pair of stylish looking sunglasses that have a video screen inside so you can watch your favorite DVD on the go. Instead of just listening to a CD, now you can watch and listen to a DVD.

Are you saying I can watch a movie with the Eyetop video glasses? Yes.

Is there sound? Yes, the Eyetop video glasses include a pair of stereo earbuds.

Tell me about the video screen? The video screen is imbedded into the right lens of the glasses. (Most people are right eye vision dominant.) This allows you the ability to be mobile and aware of what is going on around you via the left eye.

Are you saying I can watch a favorite DVD and still move about? Yes, that is the Eyetop advantage...the system is portable yet lightweight. It is designed so that you can watch a video and still move about.

How much do the glasses weigh? Only about 2 ounces.

What comes with the system? There are 3 basic components. #1 The cool blue looking video glasses. #2 A small, lightweight portable DVD player that runs on a rechargeable battery #3 A custom carrying bag that holds all the gear so you can watch your favorite DVD's on the go.

Where might I use the Eyetop + DVD system. While commuting to work on the morning train. While waiting for a plane. Or while flying on a plane. Or just sitting back in your easy chair. Or while walking the dog.

What adjustments are there? Adjustments can be made both up + down and sideways to have the video screen aimed at your eye. There is also a focus adjustment so the picture is sharp and clear.

The video screen is small. Is it high quality? The screen has 76,800 pixels in brilliant 24 bit color to deliver a high quality, crisp, sharp image.

How long do the batteries last on the Eyeglasses and DVD? The glasses are powered by 4 AA batteries that typically last about 7 to 8 hours. The DVD rechargeable battery is rated at 4 hours, or more than the length of 2 movies.

Is the product rugged? Eyetop has been supplying video glasses to military and government organizations around the globe. This product is used for targeting, remote viewing and observation. To say our product is battle field tested is no idle boast. It is designed to last.

Are there adjustments for the video image? Just like there are adjustments for your TV at home, there are adjustments you can make for color / saturation/ hue/ contrast.

Tell me about the carrying bag. The Eyetop carrying bag is custom made to give you an easy way to have video on the go while providing protection. The bag has special cut outs to hide the wires required for operation. And it comes with its' own umbrella.

There's an umbrella? Yes. On the back of the bag is a zippered pouch that holds an elastic rimmed rain proof cover to protect the entire bag. There is even a notch in the cover to accommodate the shoulder strap.

Can I use the Eyetop video glasses for anything else? Yes. The video glasses may be used separately. Any standard video device can connect to the glasses. You could connect a video game, VCR, multimedia hard drive or camcorder. Any video device that has a standard yellow RCA jack video output can be connected to the Eyetop video glasses. Imagine playing your favorite video game while wearing the Eyetop action video screen!

The portable DVD player can connect to a TV. The DVD player comes with a 40 button full function remote control.
